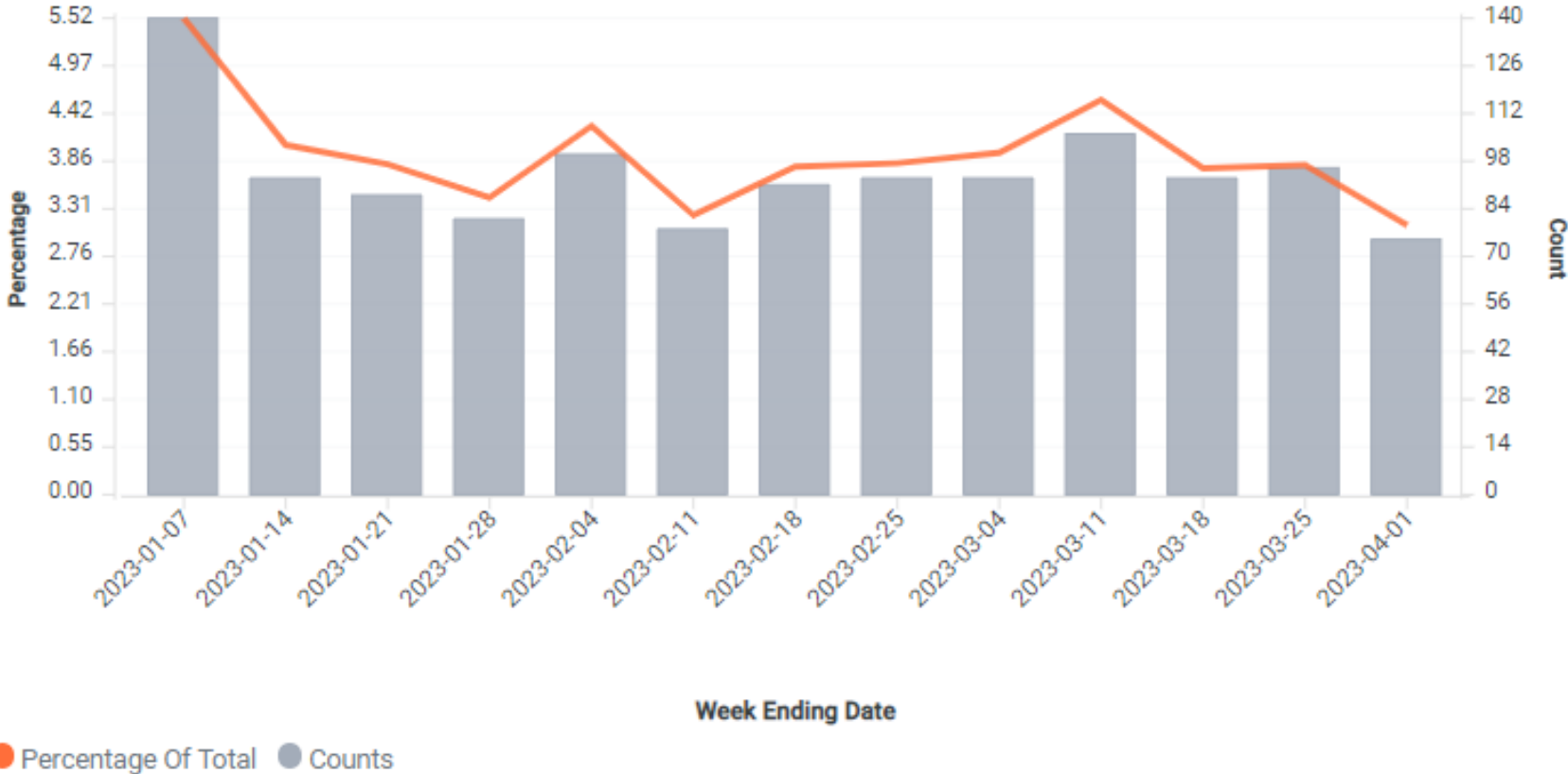

○ Downward trajectory or sustained leveling of cases over 14 days	<i>The number of cases has begun to decline in the most recent week</i>		
○ Downward trajectory of positive tests as a percentage of total tests over 14 days	<i>Gaston County Percent of Positive cases has decreased in the most recent week.</i>		
○ Downward trajectory of hospitalizations over 14 days	<i>Hospitalization level has begun to decrease in the most recent week.</i>

COUNT OF ED VISITS WITH ILI



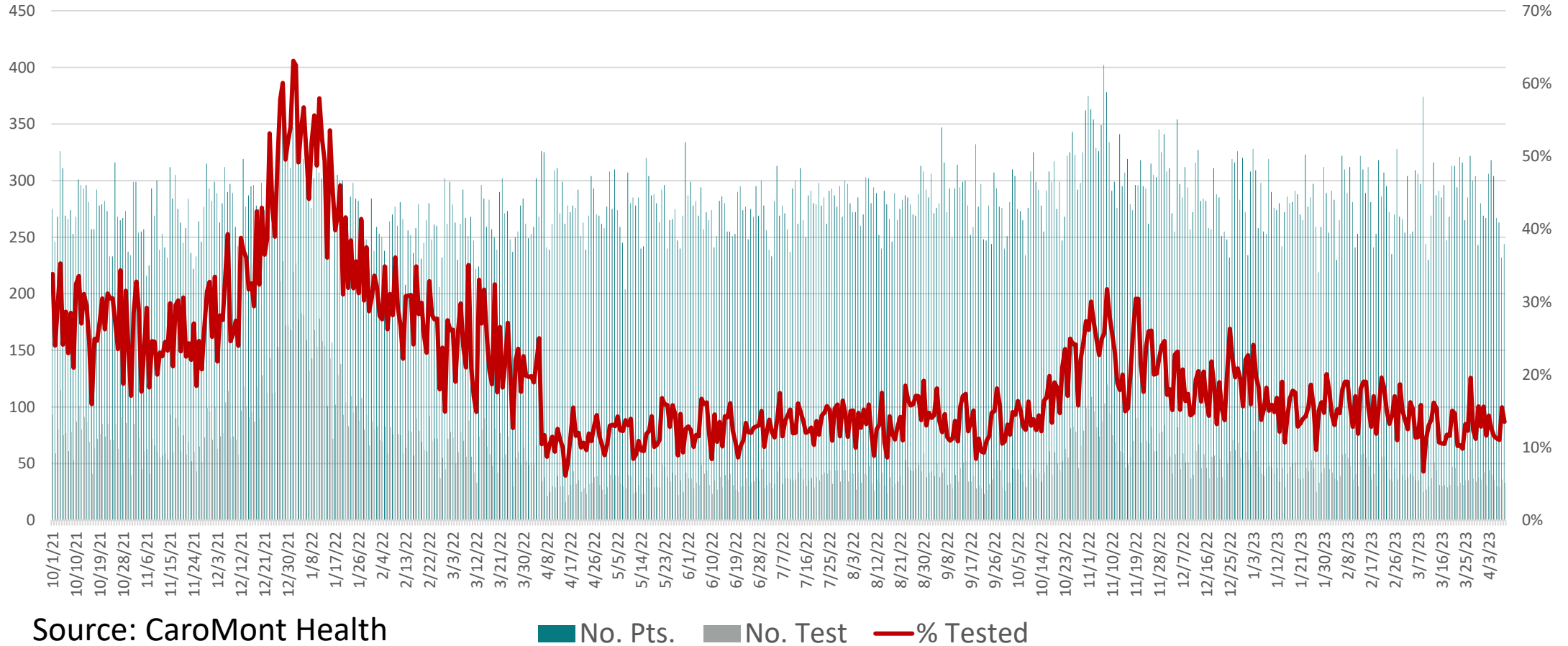
ED: ILI Percentage Of Total ED Visits by Week

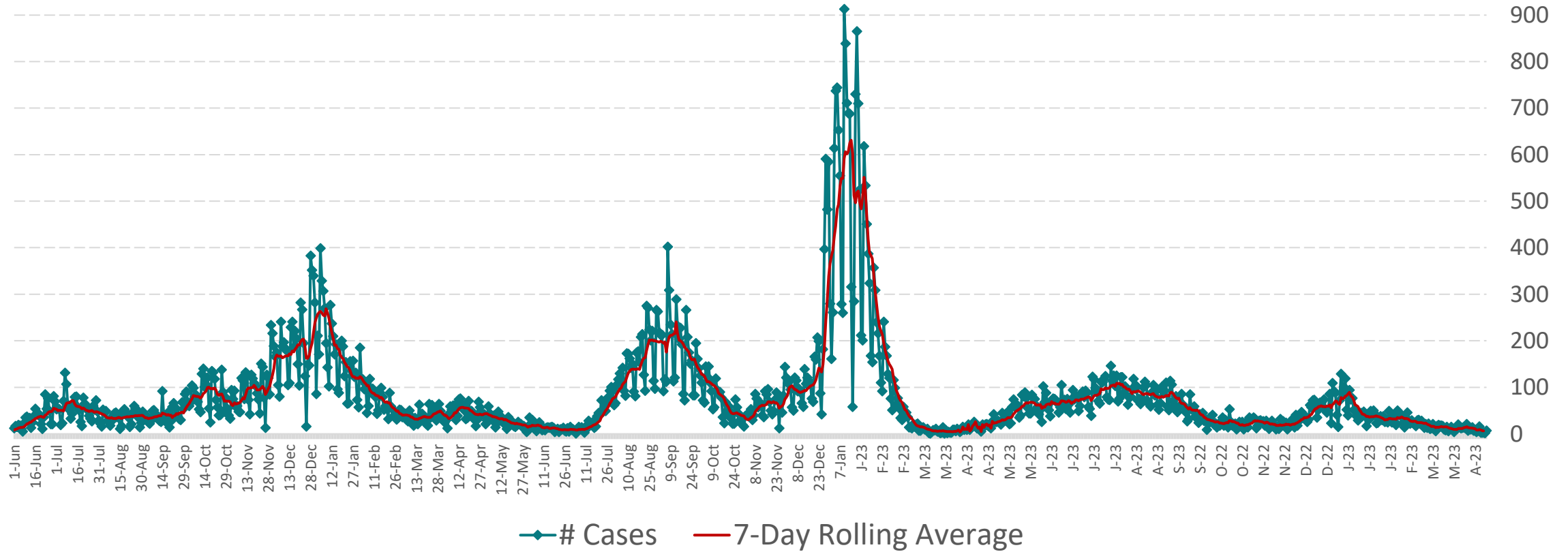

COVID-19 TESTING IN THE ED



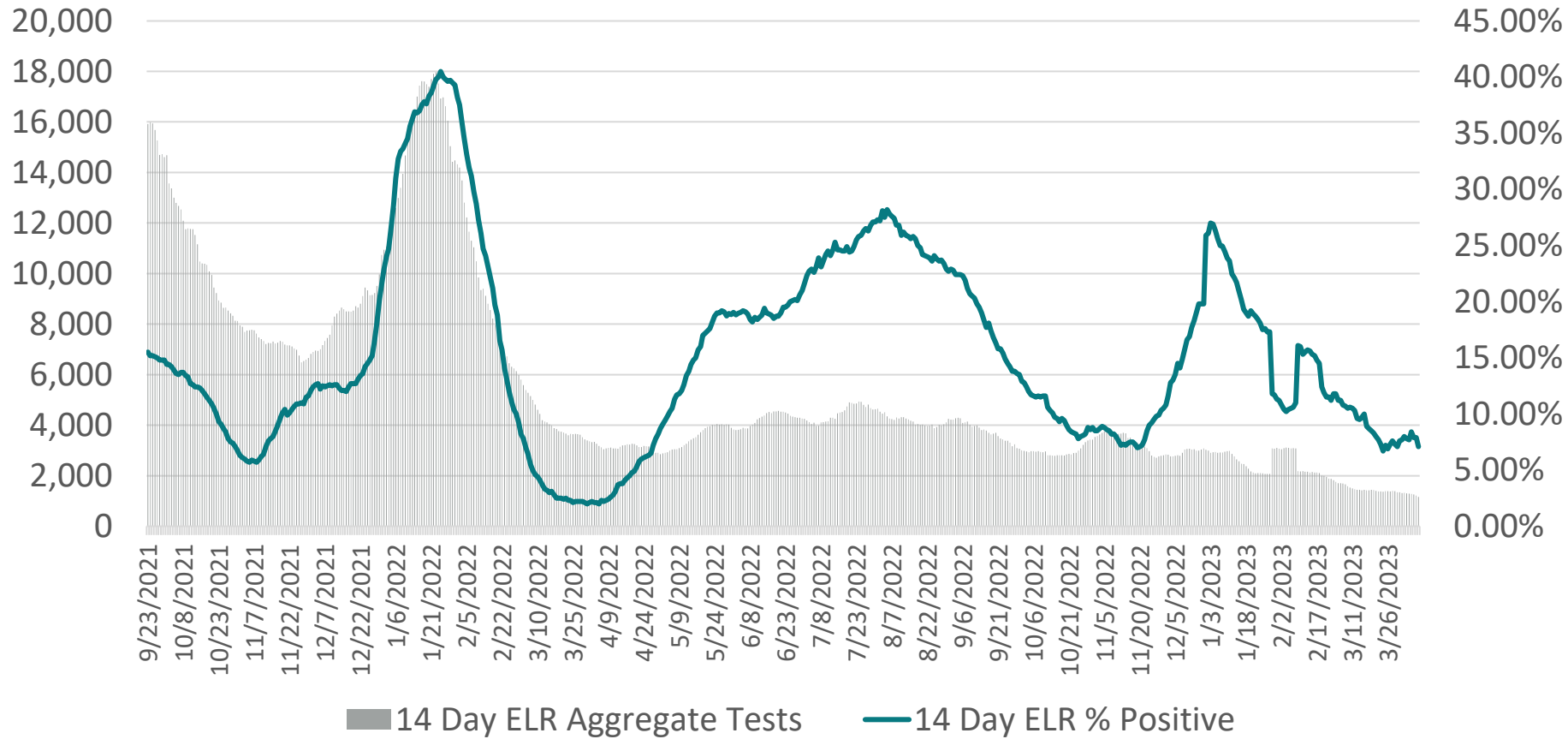

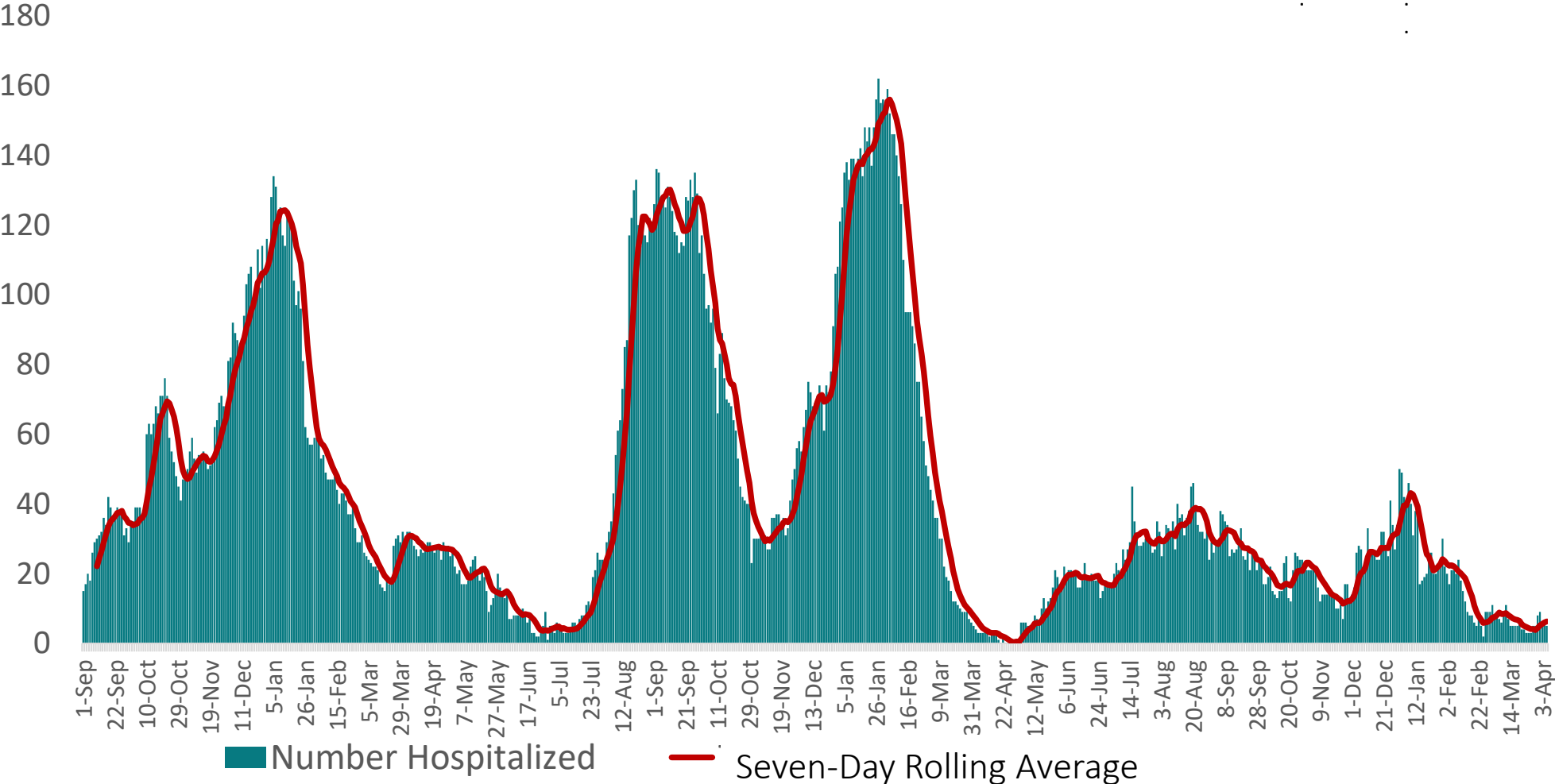

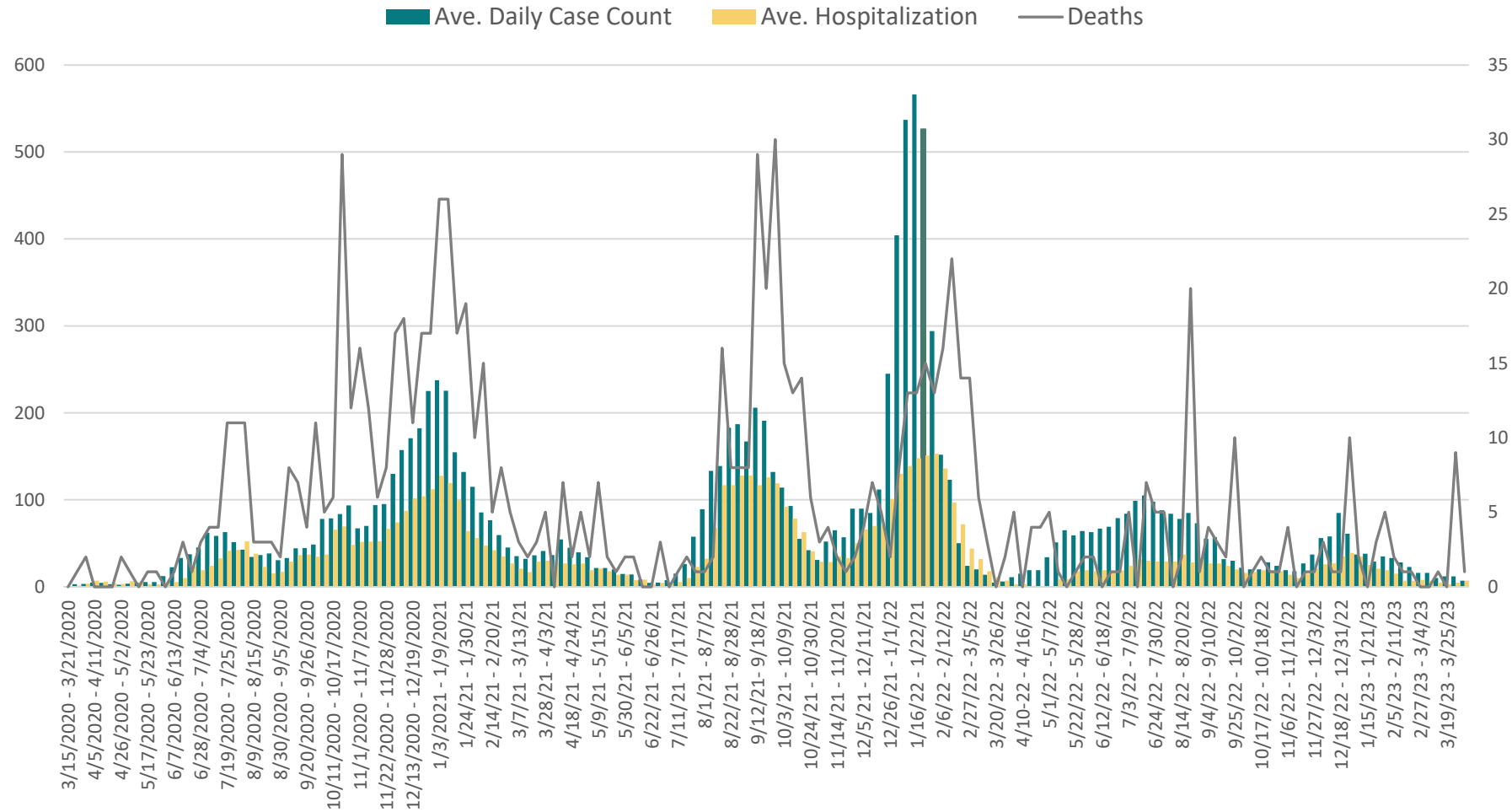
